PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Greetings from the Northeast side of Viewpoint. The temps have dropped and most of us got some rain, it's never enough but it'll do. Depending on the temps and sunshine, we might see some bursts of green over the next week or so.

With the lowering temperatures, especially at night, there is danger to outside plants. It's not just frost that hurts plants, some can't tolerate extended periods of temperatures below 40 degrees. Bring the tender ones in.

Green Valley is powered by a large Volunteer work force, the biggies like the White Elephant and Animal League couldn't function without volunteers. Everywhere you go in Green Valley you will encounter volunteers. Viewpoint depends on a small but vital group of volunteers to keep the pool and hot tub running and safe, keeping the clubhouse and grounds reasonably well maintained, and other projects as needed. We can always use more volunteers, particularly with the pool monitoring. Pima County regulations require checking the pool chemistry twice a day, every day, 365 days a year. If you use the pool, you should consider volunteering to "check the pool". We are also looking for someone to take on the task of Pool Captain, who would coordinate the efforts of the pool monitors and deal with the few but inevitable "issues", such as "the hot tub is cold", or leaks in the pump room, or the 101 things that come up. We have pool service providers that provides excellent support, but any service beyond the current cleaning and chemical adjustments is up the us to provide. If this might interest you, please contact me directly.

Check out the exact wording on the website or in your CC&R's.

Basically, if you have relatives and friends visiting, they can park overnight in your driveway or at the curb as long as it isn't blocking a driveway.

However, if you're just parking your vehicle (whether that be a car, van, recreational vehicle, boat, etc.) in your driveway instead of in your garage, you're allowed to leave it there for 72 hours for loading, unloading, and/or minor maintenance. Other than that, you need to find other means of storage. (There are many storage options available. Some are very close by – right on Camino Casa Verde.)
