PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

This required a multi-step repair; removing the rust, cleaning the pipe, and applying a "liner" to prevent any further damage. During these repairs it became evident that there were other problems in the current system requiring attention in the near future. All of the issues are addressable, and will be addressed as appropriate.

Nice to see the pool getting some use, for me as a buyer it was a significant draw to Viewpoint. It is always warm (87 degrees), always clean, always welcoming. You should be enjoying it. I do.



HELP MINIMIZE WASTE AND KEEP OUR CLUBHOUSE CLEAN

In an attempt to minimize waste, reduce the use of one-time plastic and reduce our carbon footprint, there are "real" plates and silverware for use in the Clubhouse for socials and luncheons.

Because of the delicate nature of our pipes and garbage disposal, please scrape foodstuffs into the garbage and take the garbage bags with you. (There is no trash service at the Clubhouse.) If you don't want to wash the dishes by hand, feel free to use the dishwasher. As a side note, anyone is welcome to bring their own plates and/or utensils to socials.

A catch-all screen is over the garbage disposal to minimize food clogging the drains. Please use accordingly to avoid pricey repairs. (See the minutes of our last board meeting for more information.) NO coffee grounds in the disposal, please!

We just paid over \$300 to have an industrial grade wax applied to our aging vinyl floor. We have also installed felt pads on the bottom of all the upholstered chairs to help mitigate scratches to the floor. When possible, please pick up chairs to move them so we save the costs of having to replace the flooring!
