Communications/Website: Dick Horn has received a lot of questions about our website. He put together about a 5-minute presentation to address the questions and describe how the website was constructed. Garbage Committee: Diane Helser presented an overview of where we sit with each of the three companies we are researching for the end of our contract.

Arroyo and Camino Casa Verde Cleanup: The cleanup has already been done. Maintenance will be handled by Points West. The county came and cleaned up East and West on Via Alamos.

New Business:

Pool and Spa: Drain and re-caulk of tiles will be the upcoming repairs, which are in the Proposed Budget. It will be down for approximately one week. This fix should hold for approximately 10 years. We will notify the residents when we have the contract and know when the work will occur. We are also trying to determine what to do with the surface of the section under the protected area which is bubbling and peeling when it gets wet.

Library: Barb Doering wants recommendations as to how to maintain the library. We are running out of space.

Questions/Comments: The entire board was thanked for the upgrades to the landscaping around the clubhouse.

The quality of the Shuffleboard Court has been in such disrepair that it will be changed to an area for Cornhole.
